RE: State of the U.S. Senate Race in Georgia

Information regarding Herschel Walker's record of violence is currently reaching a small number of voters through paid advertising.

While this is an important conversation that speaks to Herschel Walker's readiness to represent the people of Georgia and one that more voters should hear about, that communication should take place **over the final two months** of the campaign.

Any conversation of Walker's record of violence should start by clearly documenting Walker's threats against his ex-wife, the official police reports documenting those threats and Walker's ex-wife's descriptions of Walker's behavior. While there are other examples of Walker's record of violent behavior, it is important voters first learn of his actions toward his ex-wife in order to understand who he really is.

At the point that the discussion moves beyond Walker's violence towards his ex-wife, again, news coverage and police reports tell the story of Walker's actions very plainly. There is little need for voters to see much beyond this coverage and the official documents to understand what took place. The coverage and documents speak for themselves.
